TEMPLE FUNDS

Donations (monthly acknowledgements are listed on the previous page) are gratefully accepted for the following:

General Operating Fund—For the day-to-day operation of TBE.

Biblical Garden Fund—To provide the infrastructure for biblical plants and trees, and bricks in the fountain meditation area and on the brick walkway.

Rabbi Larry and Rhonda Karol Campership Fund—Providing scholarships for Temple students to attend Jewish summer camp programs.

Results of Your Voice – Our Future Congregational Meetings

During the month of April, seventy-six members of our congregation attended one of five meetings and followed a discussion process designed to determine congregational values we could translate into search criteria to help us find a permanent Spiritual Leader for Temple Beth-El. The following is a summary of the results of those meetings, which I reported at our Annual Meeting on May 22.

Discussions centered around responses to the following three questions:

1. What brings you/would bring you to Shabbat worship?
2. What aspects of Judaism/Jewish life do you value the most?
3. Why do you belong to a temple/synagogue?

Participants ranked their responses as "Most Important," "Important," and "Less Important." I then compiled responses from all five meetings and produced the following recommendations for search criteria – the attributes of the ideal candidate:

- **A Community Builder with Strong Interpersonal Skills:** able to relate to all demographics, committed to outreach and growing the congregation, able to create engaging intergenerational programs, experienced in pastoral care.
- **Committed to Lifelong Learning:** engaging teaching style for all demographics, deep knowledge of Jewish History, Torah/Talmud, liturgy, strong Hebrew skills.
- **Engaging Pulpit Presence:** encourages participation in singing and prayer, musical ability and familiarity with the breadth of Jewish music.
- **Strong Communications Skills:** – Written and Verbal: able to create and deliver timely, thoughtful d'verei Torah and sermons, committed to timely and transparent communications with congregants.
- **Committed to Tikkun Olam (Repairing the World):** eager to represent the congregation in the greater community as a champion of social justice.

Using this information, the Board will put together a search committee and soon begin the process of finding and recruiting a permanent Spiritual Leader. I want to thank everyone who participated in our April meetings, and I look forward to working with all of you when I assume my interim leadership position on August 1.
